➤ The PTA have recently organized the uniform cupboards – plenty of pieces of uniform are available should you require any – simply enquire at the office should you need anything.

- Christmas cards and Christmas hampers have and are in the process of being completed with support from the PTA. Donations for hampers will be much appreciated as will support of the Christmas card requests.
- ➤ Meltham Moor Big Dig! The PTA are creating a project to tidy up and manage the woodland area and revamp the memorial garden. Both areas need a general tidy up and then someone to manage the maintenance and upkeep of both sites going forward. Any help would be appreciated in any of the following areas:-
 - Clearing and straightening the paving and steps
 - Mending and fixing fencing
 - Clearing planters and raised beds
 - Cutting the grass
 - Deciding what to plant and planting
 - General upkeep

There is even a pond area which, if anyone has the knowledge or experience to clear and bring into a condition that the children could enjoy, would be a brilliant addition to the area as well.

➤ Woodlands Plan – Some work has already been done on the woodland area but further help to clear fallen branches, mend fences, spread bark chippings and create paths would make the area much easier and more enjoyable for the children to use. We are also looking at creating a second woodland area, specifically for KS1, so any ideas and support in this would be welcome as well.
